Scope - Soheil Mosun Limited was contracted to manufacture and install the coffered brass and mirror ceilings in the main floor lobby and the thirty second floor sky lobby, custom screens throughout the building in common areas, as well as grills, sills and footrests in the main floor bar and lounge. Also, CNC cut stainless steel ceilings with floral designs are located in hotel and residential elevator lobbies.

Highlights - Coffered ceilings are bronze and mirrors with lighting fixtures built in. The various screens are made of wood, steel, stainless steel and bronze with wood being painted to specification and metal parts receiving a painted finish. CNC cut stainless steel panels with floral pattern and ambient lighting fixtures within, adorn the ceilings of both the residential and hotel elevator lobbies.
